Report of the Trustees

The trustees are pleased to present the annual report, together with the financial statements for the charity for the year ended 31st December 2025.

Basis of the Accounts

The financial statements comply with the Charities Act 2011 and are for the 12-month period ending 31st December 2025. As the gross income for the period is above the threshold of £25,000, the trustees have opted to carry out an independent examination with an external source, as there is the requirement to do so.

Objectives & Charity Statement

The objective of the Society is to educate the public in the dramatic and operatic arts, and to further the development of public appreciation, and taste in the said arts and in furtherance of this object but not otherwise the Society through its management committee shall have the following powers:

- To promote plays, drama, comedies, operas, operettas and other dramatic and operatic works of educative value.
- To purchase, acquire and obtain interests in the copyright, or the right to perform or show, any such dramatic or operatic works.
- To purchase or otherwise acquire plant & machinery, furniture, fixtures & fittings, scenery and all other necessary effects.
- To raise funds and invite and receive contributions from any person or persons whatsoever by way of subscription, donation and otherwise, provided that the society shall not undertake any permanent trading activities in raising funds.
- To do all such other things as shall further the objects of the Society

Chairman's Report

Over the last year, CAMUS premiered the show Made in Dagenham in June 2025. Although ticket sales were strong with a total of 67% sold, we unfortunately made a loss totalling £2,266. The committee attribute this loss purely to the drop in ticket sales when compared to the show budgeted amount. For the next show, we have budgeted more stringently with a more conservative ticket sales estimate and budget lines based on 2025 costs.

In October 2025, CAMUS premiered their first play And Then There Were None. We were pleased to sell out 2 full nights of performances, however, due to losing a night's ticket sales and some unexpected set design costs, we ended the show budget with a loss of £571.

2025 was a successful year for fundraising with a number of popular events taking place. This resulted in a total profit of £2,269. This includes a very generous donation from Camberley Playgoers Society of £888 and we would like to thank them for their patronage.

Finally, our general fund, which includes membership and general expenses, made an overall loss of £1,220. In 2026, we have revised our membership offer and allocated show related expenses to the shows, including insurance, which should mitigate this loss moving forwards.
