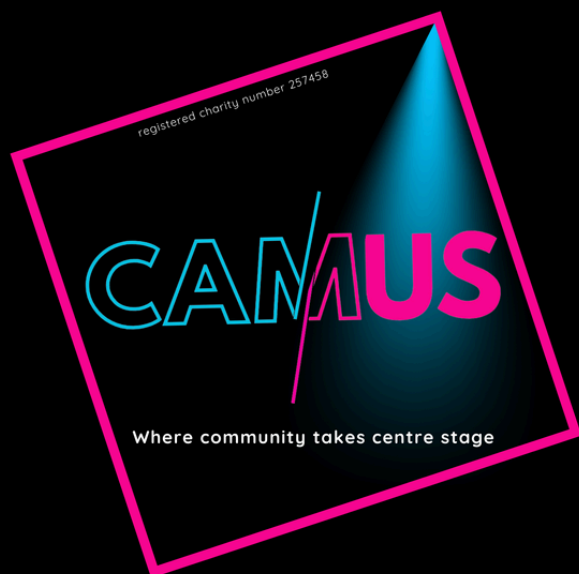

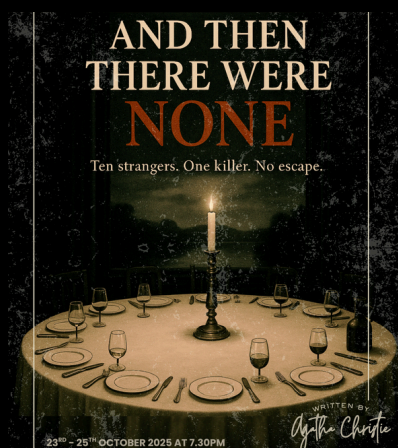

### FARNBOROUGH DONKEY DERBY



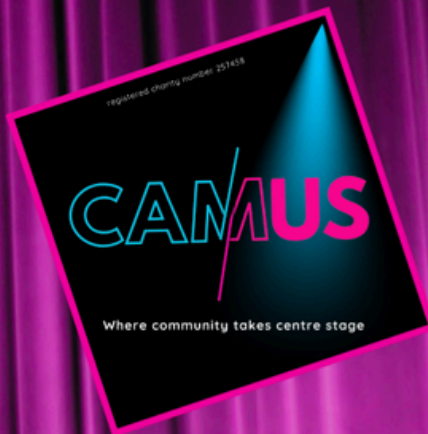

# MEMBERSHIP UPDATE



## Membership


The new membership structure, as approved at the recent AGM, will come into effect on 1st January 2026. These changes are designed to offer greater flexibility and sustainability for our members and the society as a whole. The updated structure will apply to all members, including those participating in our forthcoming production of Sweeney Todd.

Members will pay an annual membership fee of £50, rather than the monthly Membership taken by Direct Debit payment of £13. This option includes full membership benefits and is for all performing and non-performing members. **Performing members:** will pay the Annual Membership + a one off Show Fee for each production you participate in. The show fee amount may vary depending on the specific production.

We understand that flexibility is important, so an instalment payment plan will be available for those who need it. If you'd like to explore this option, please speak to Gareth, our Treasurer, who will be happy to provide more information and assist with arrangements.

These changes reflect our commitment to keeping CAMUS inclusive, accessible, and financially stable, and we appreciate your continued support.

Being a member of CAMUS offers more than just the opportunity to participate in productions or support our shows as an audience member—it means becoming part of the CAMUS family. As such, we believe every member has the right to feel safe, to be heard, and to uphold our Code of Conduct. We have recently introduced several important documents, now available on our website, to support our shared values and responsibilities. These include the CAMUS Constitution, the Code of Conduct, our Privacy Statement for Members, and our new Safeguarding Documents.



## Member Benefits

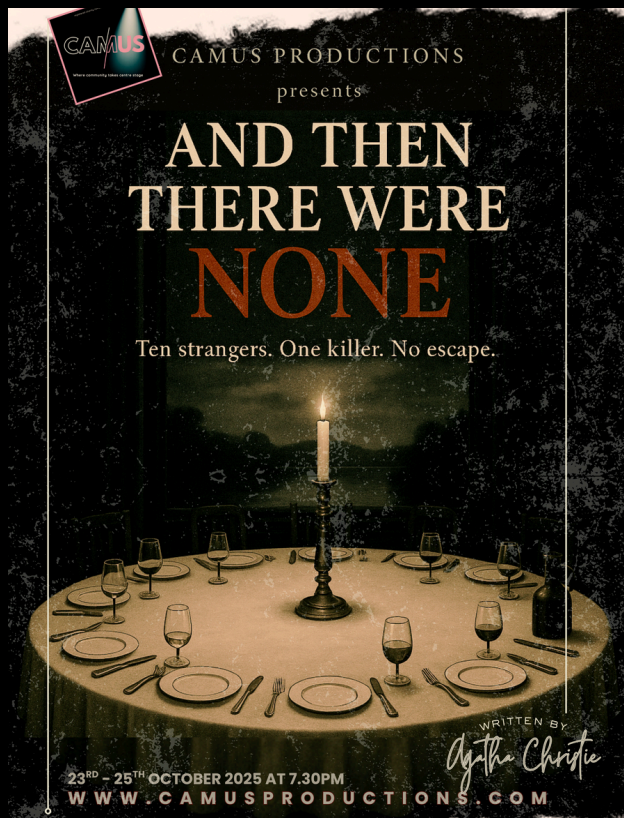
