Approval of minutes

The minutes from the last meeting were approved.

1. Welcome from NY

NY welcomed the group. Actions from the previous meeting were updated / approved.

2. Financial Report

As of 30th April, the current bank balance stands at £11,447.76, with £67.00 in the deposit account.

There have been **no significant financial changes** since the last meeting. The **Membership Report** was circulated in advance. [see attached]

Show fees are still being followed up. It was agreed that Mike Wood should be removed from the 'chaser' list and replaced by Dale Barrell.

Gift Aid claims will be pursued by GB following further cast follow-up at this evening's rehearsal.

A query was raised by **LR** regarding **Dale Barrell's show fee**. It was suggested that, as he is stepping in, a **nominal fee** be applied—specifically, the **monthly membership fee of £13.00** for the duration of his participation, to cover insurance. GB will confirm with Dale.
